Projects > Embroidered Holiday Belt

Get ahead of holiday rush; create this classy holiday belt that's stylish enough to wear year round!

Materials and Supplies

- Brother Sewing/Embroidery Machine
- <u>SA373</u> Brother Embroidery Card Japanese Style, Design #44
- <u>SA5906</u> Brother Aqua-Melt Adhesive Backed Stabilizer
- <u>SA999</u> Brother Gold Metallic Embroidery Thread
- Large embroidery hoop
- SA186 Brother Open Toe Foot
- Craft Felt
- Purchased or recycled belt buckle




Instructions

- 1. Place the embroidery card (SA373) in the machine.
- 2. Open Embroidery Edit.
- 3. Select Design #44. Press SET.
- Duplicate the design to fill up the largest hoop.See Figure #1

NOTE: If using a large embroidery hoop bring as many designs onto the screen that will fit in the hoop. The Quattro's 12" x 8" hoop will hold 12 designs. Space out the designs to allow room for cutting. Using the "border" feature will also allow the machine to sort the colors in one touch of a button.

- **5.** Touch EDIT END.
- **6.** Hoop the Brother SA5906 Aqua-Melt Adhesive Backed Stabilizer.
- 7. Center the craft felt and press onto the stabilizer.
- **8.** Embroider the designs.





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- **9.** Remove from hoop and trim each disk close to the edge of the design. See Figure #2
- **10.**Attach the Open Toe foot.
- **11.**Select SEWING.
- **12.**In Utility Stitch Mode, touch the Buttonhole tab, and select the button sewing stitch.
- 13.Place the embroidered circles side by side and stitch together with the button sewing stitch.See Figure #3
- **14.**When sewing the last two circles, (be sure to measure the length needed) stitch two button stitches, leaving an opening to allow the belt buckle tab to fit in the middle.
- **15.**Fold the last circle to the back and use the button stitch to secure in several places. See Figure #4
