Scan Cut PAPER GARLAND projects

I love garlands and I am always looking for unique ways to create simple ones. I used my Brother™ ScanNCut to create three really fun and creative garlands!

MATERIALS:

Brother $^{\text{\tiny{TM}}}$ ScanNCut machine, white paper, colored paper, white ribbon, glue gun





I started by cutting simple shapes from my ScanNCut machine. I used a variety of the built-in shapes (triangles, circles and hearts) and cut them in a mix of colors.

Tip: For thin papers, use the low tack mat and for thicker papers the standard mat.

step 2. Next, I glued my shapes (with my glue gun) to a white ribbon.







PAPER GARLAND (CONTINUED)

(Additional Idea #2): I used the same process to create a word garland! I used the letters that were preloaded in the machine and glued them to another ribbon.

(Additional Ideal #3): Then I decided to get even more creative! I scanned a line drawing of a flower doodle, cut out my doodle and glued to a ribbon.

step 5. And just like that - three fun and EASY garlands!
