

# Valentine's Day Wreath


Get your home "Valentine-ready" with this easy, no-sew Valentine's Day wreath!

### **MATERIALS:**

ScanNCut Machine and Accessories; ScanNCut High Tack Fabric Support Sheet; Large Valentine Wreath (for base); Wire Cutters; 1 Yard of Batting; 1 Yard of Fabric; 9" x 12" Pieces of Craft Felt (3 pieces: one red, one pink, one black); 1 ¼" Wood Dowel; White Acrylic Paint; Fiber Fill Stuffing; Ribbon; Pearl Pins; Hot Glue Gun and Glue

**step 1.** Place the ScanNCut High Tack Fabric Support Sheet onto your ScanNCut mat, and adhere a piece of felt onto it.

**step 2.** Do a test cut first. Cut out 8 red felt pieces and 6 pink felt pieces of pre-installed shape BA-A067 (heart) and 2 black felt pieces of shape BA-A030.











## VALENTINE'S DAY WREATH (CONTINUED)

**step 3.** Disassemble the Valentine's wreath to get the heart-shaped base. You may need to use wire cutters to remove the decorations.



**step 4.** Wrap strips of approximately 5" wide batting around the heart base, covering it completely.



**step 5.** Wrap strips of approximately 5" wide fabric over the batting, and glue into place with hot glue.



**step 6.** Set two red felt hearts aside and arrange the remaining felt hearts as desired and glue into place.







step 7. Paint the wood dowel white and allow it to dry.

step 8. With the remaining two hearts, hot glue the edges together and leave a gap so you can stuff it. Do the same with the black "feathers."



**step 9.** Stuff the heart and feathers with stuffing.



step 10. Apply hot glue to the end of the dowel and insert it into the heart and then glue the heart closed. Repeat with the "feathers" at the other end of the dowel.

step 12. Attach a ribbon to the top of the wreath and insert pearl pins into the hearts for embellishment.
