

## Projects > Roses & Ribbon Valentine Card

Warm someone's heart with this charming card! Perfect for Valentine's Day or any day you want to make special!

### Materials and Supplies

- **Brother ULT Series Embroidery/Sewing Machine**
- Built-in "Roses" design
- Built-in Font #1
- 4" x 4" hoop
- **Brother Water Soluble Stabilizer**
- Sticky back stabilizer
- Blank stock card with an oval cut out on the front cover
- 5" x 5" medium weight lace material
- **Brother Embroidery Thread - #010, #513, #515, and #800**
- Additional piece of stock card paper, measured to the size of the card
- Temporary adhesive spray
- 12" ribbon to form a bow (we used shear lacy red)
- Decorative hearts in different sizes (made from construction paper or soft foam)
- Any other decorations to embellish your card



### Instructions

1. Using Brother water soluble stabilizer (SA517), hoop a 4" x 4" frame (one layer in the hoop).
2. Lightly spray the stabilizer with temporary adhesive spray and place the lace on top of the stabilizer.
3. Embroider the rose design in the center of the lace.
4. Select "embroidery edit" on your machine (for the embroidered wording inside the card).
5. Select the words (Happy Valentine's Day) separately.

**Note:** Using the grid that is built into your machine will enable you to space the words evenly. This is a nice feature of the Brother machine, as it allows you to change the size and array of your lettering.

6. Set your machine speed on 350, as you will be stitching on paper.

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7. To embroider the words "Happy Valentine's Day" onto the separate card stock, place the sticky back stabilizer in the 4" x 4" frame, and center the card stock in the middle of the frame.
8. Embroider each word separately.
9. While leaving the stabilizer on the back, cut around the card stock paper to fit the measurements inside the card.
10. Glue the embroidered card stock to the inside of the card. (Embroidering the letters on a separate piece of paper will allow the back of your embroidery to be hidden.)
11. Cut your embroidered lace down to the size of the card, place it behind your oval opening and glue it down.
12. Make a small bow from the ribbon and glue it onto the bouquet of flowers.
13. Decorate the inside of the card using cut out hearts and flowers.
14. Give to someone special!
